

# Folding Down— How Paper Becomes a Book

## GRAIN

The direction in which paper fibers line up. The fold is easier/natural along the grain.

## FOLIO

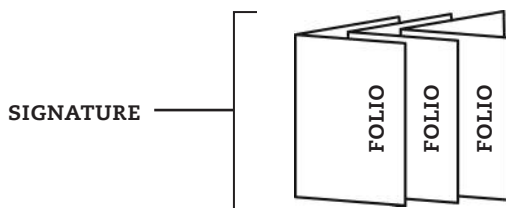
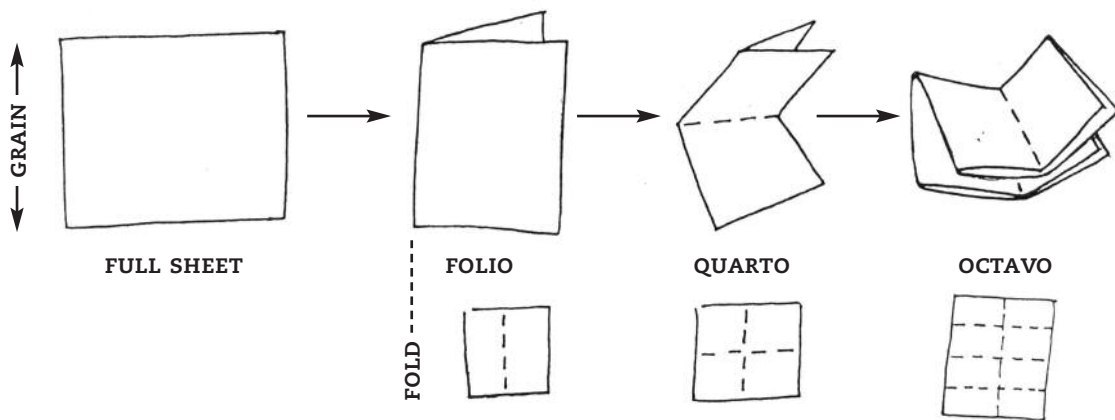
1 sheet folded 1 time to create 2 sections or 4 pages

## QUARTO

1 sheet folded 2 times to create 4 sections and when folds are cut creates 8 pages

## OCTAVO

1 sheet folded 3 times to create 8 sections and when folds are cut creates 16 pages



## SEWING STATION

Holes that you sew through when binding a multiple section/signature book

## SECTION OR SIGNATURE

2 or more folios placed one inside of the other
